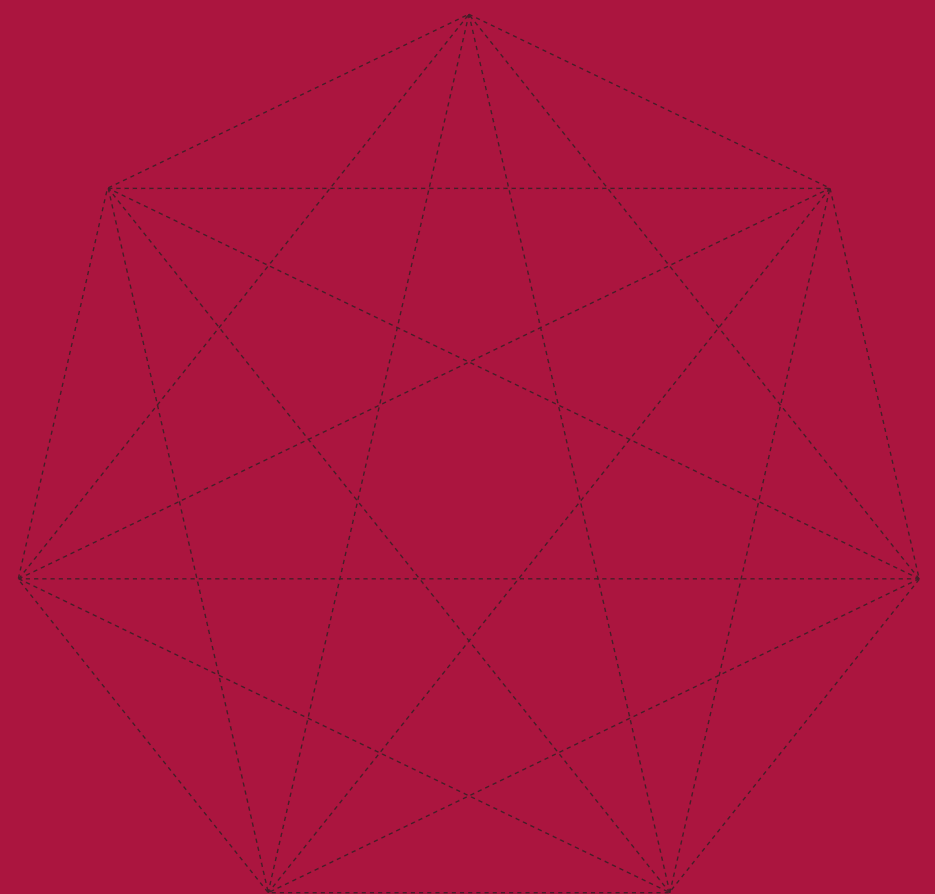

APPLICATIONS

APPLICATION DATES

The applications of our students who would like to benefit from Erasmus+ 2025 Project Year Internship Mobility Program will be received ONLINE between 11.11.2024 – 11.12.2024. Erasmus+ Internship Mobility Application can be found in turnaportal.ua.gov.tr. Please carefully read the Online Application Guide regarding the application system.

ERASMUS+ ENGLISH LANGUAGE EXAM

Erasmus+ English Language Exam will be held face to face at Istanbul Nişantaşı University campus. The exact timing will be announced later.

Note: It is obligatory to have your student IDs with you during the exam, to show your ID to the instructor before starting the exam, and to sign the attendance list.

Those who do not have their student ID cards with them will not be allowed to sit for the exam. And the exams of those who do not sign the attendance list, will be deemed invalid.

Participation in the exam is mandatory for Erasmus+ Internship Mobility. Requirements are minimum 60 points for Erasmus+ Internship Mobility Program from the English Foreign Language Exam.

ATTENTION!

Language exams such as YDS, TOEFL, IELTS are not accepted. It is compulsory for every student to take the language exam held by our university.

Students who are abroad or out of Istanbul for Erasmus+ Mobility Program also can apply; but in the period of the foreign language exam, students are required to take part in the exam in Istanbul, Türkiye. Students who are staying abroad or any other city of Türkiye on the exam date will not be regarded as a force majeure.



Necessary Points:

*Students who are entitled to receive a grant within the framework of Erasmus+ Internship Mobility can receive grants for 1 semester.

* Erasmus+ Study and Internship Mobility can be held up to a total of 12 months at each level of education (first degree: associate degree, bachelor's degree; second degree: Master's degree; third degree: doctorate, specialization in medicine).

WHO CAN APPLY?

Students who are in the 1st and 2nd grades of Formal Education (1st and 2nd Education) Associate, Undergraduate and Postgraduate students at Istanbul Nişantaşı University can apply for internship mobility.

Students enrolled in the Double Major / Minor Program can only apply from one Major.

Those who have previously carried out Erasmus+ Mobility Program at the same and/or previous level of education can apply. However, it should not be forgotten that Erasmus+ Mobility can be done up to 12 months in total at each education level.

Final year students can also apply for the Erasmus+ Internship Mobility program. Students who apply and are selected can complete their mobility within 12 months after graduation, as long as it falls within the validity period of the relevant project.

If your department/faculty deems it appropriate, you can carry out your IMU internship under the Erasmus program. For approval of eligibility, please consult your department head.

Students who are continuing their education at our university through any exchange program are not eligible to apply.

Attention: Students who have not renewed their registration and inactive students who have graduated are not eligible to apply for Erasmus+ Mobility.



Erasmus+ Internship Mobility Application Requirements

1)An active student enrolled in a higher education program at any of the formal education levels (Associate, Undergraduate, Graduate) within the higher education institution can apply:

2)a) Students must have at least 2.20 / 4.00 GPA for a Bachelor/ Associate Degree

b)GPA must be at least 3,00 / 4.00 for the Master and Doctorate students

Students who haven't met these criteria cannot apply.

3)It doesn't prevent them from taking part in the Erasmus+ Internship Mobility Program if students have failed courses.

4)The total duration of Internship Mobility that will benefit from the higher education mobility activities during the Erasmus+ and Lifelong Learning(LLP) period within the current education level cannot exceed 12 months.

5)Graduate and Ph.D. students, who will apply for the first semester and have not yet had a transcript in our university, cannot apply.

6)Those who have transferred from another higher education institution and haven't yet achieved a grade point average, the grade averages in the transcript they receive from the higher education institution they take are taken into consideration.





ATTENTION!

- Students must ensure that their Grade Point Average (GPA) is up-to-date and accurate in the OBIS system before the APPLICATION PROCESS. Since the GPA displayed in the system will be considered during the application, it is important for students to check the OBIS system and, if applicable, correct any missing courses or grades through the Student Affairs Office. Corrections made after the application process has been completed will not be taken into account.

Evaluation Criteria

It will be taken into consideration 50% of the Erasmus+ English Language Score and 50% of the General Weighted Grade Point Average (GPA). The sum of these points constitutes the final score (Erasmus+ Score).

According to the evaluation criteria stated below, the student's final score (Erasmus+Score) must be a minimum of 59 for Erasmus+ Internship Mobility.

Reminder: The threshold for passing the Erasmus+ English Language exam is minimum 60 points for Erasmus+ Internship Mobility.

SELECTION CRITERIA AND WEIGHTED POINTS TO BE USED IN EVALUATING APPLICATIONS

To the children of martyrs and veterans	+15 points ²
Students with disabilities (provided the disability is documented)	+10 points ³
Under the Social Services Law No. 2828 for students who have been given protection, care or accommodation decisions.	+10 points ⁴
Themselves or their first-degree relatives from AFAD recipients of disaster relief	+10 points
Submitting an acceptance letter at the time of application	+10 points
Earlier benefit within the scope of same project (with or without grant)	-10 points ⁵
Internships to develop digital skills (DOTs) are prioritized	+5 points ⁶
Participating in mobility in the country of citizenship	-10 points
Failure to participate in the mobility without submitting a waiver notification in due time despite being selected for mobility	-10 points
Applying two types of mobility at the same time (reduction is applied to the student's preferred type of mobility)	-10 points
For students selected for mobility: Not attending meetings/training organized by the higher education institution on mobility without an excuse (applicable if the student re-applies to Erasmus)	-5 points
Declaring that they will take the language exam without an excuse not to enter (applicable if the student re-applies to Erasmus)	-5 points

** ASSESSMENT IN THE MOBILITY OF THE APPLICATION, THE APPLICATION IS MADE BY THE DECISION OF THE UNIT COMMISSION AND IN THE MOBILITY OF THE INTERNSHIP, BY THE DECISION OF THE ERASMUS INSTITUTIONAL COORDINATION COMMISSION.

***IN ORDER TO PRIORITIZE, THE STUDENT MUST SUBMIT A LETTER FROM THE MINISTRY OF FAMILY AND SOCIAL POLICIES REGARDING THE PROTECTION, CARE OR SHELTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW NO. 2828 DURING THE APPLICATION PERIOD.

QUOTAS

The quota for the 2025 Project Year is 13. The quotas are distributed on a faculty basis and are detailed in the table below. If there is no application from any faculty, all applicants will be ranked in order of success and the student of the faculty with the highest score will be given the right. Students who are on the backup list can participate in the mobility without a grant if they submit a petition within the specified time.

Attention: “The 2025 Contribution Agreement between Türkiye and the European Commission has not been signed yet. For this reason, being selected for mobility with or without a grant as a result of your application within the scope of Erasmus+ student internship mobility does not constitute an acquired right. "Whether you will receive a grant or the amount of your grant will be finalized when the agreement to be signed with the European Commission and the subsequent grant allocation processes to be allocated to our university are finalized, and our university or the Turkish National Agency cannot be held responsible for any material or moral losses that may arise from delays or disruptions in the said agreement processes."

Grant Amounts According to the Visited Countries

Grants are given to students to help them with their additional expenses resulting from being abroad during their study period. Grants are only for contribution, and not intended to cover all the student's mobility costs. For Erasmus+ Mobility, students are not supported for round- trip journeys.

The countries where student mobility activities can be carried out were divided into 3 groups according to their living standards, and monthly study grants were determined for the country groups. The country groups and monthly grants are given in the table below for the students who will go to these countries:

* In academic matters, students should contact the Erasmus Department Coordinators regarding all questions.

*You can send an e-mail to erasmus@nisantasi.edu.tr regarding the technical problems you face regarding the applications.

Students who submit their applications by making an incorrect or incomplete application do not have the right to change their applications again. Therefore, you should be careful while applying.
