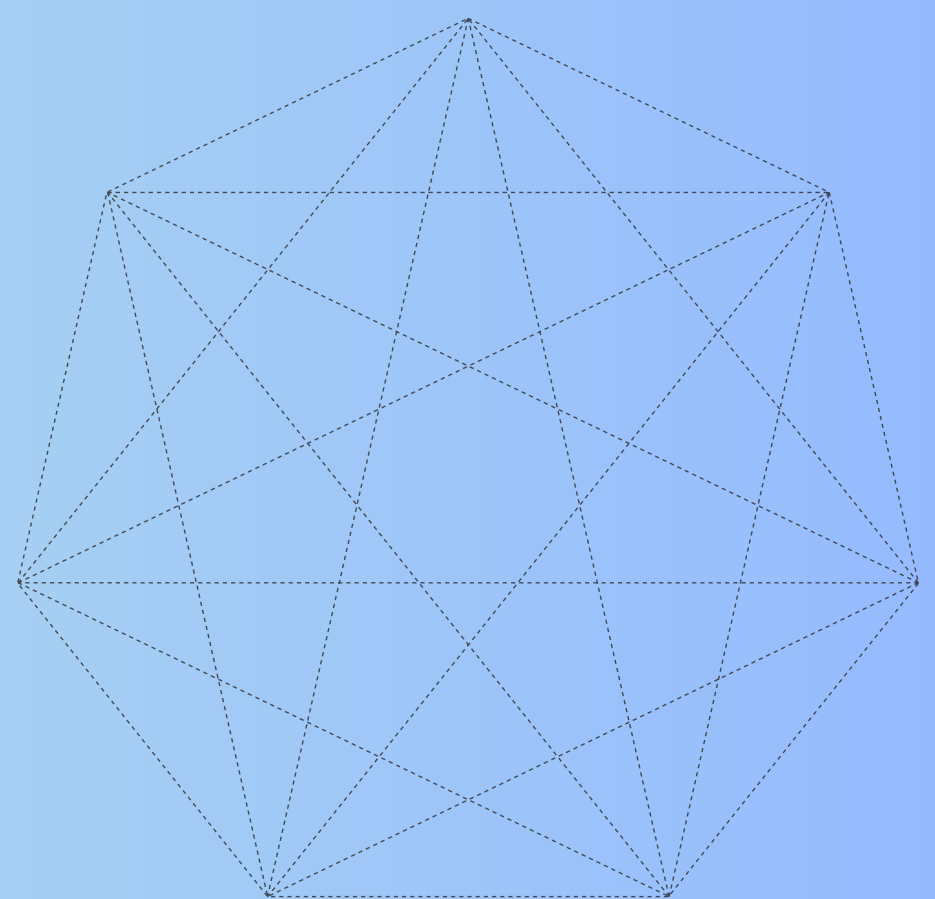

APPLICATION DATES

The applications of our students who would like to benefit from Erasmus+ 2024-1-TR01-KA171-HED-000219519 Project Study Mobility Program will be received ONLINE between 01.08.2025 – 01.09.2025 Erasmus+ Study Mobility Application can be found in turnaportal.uea.gov.tr. Please carefully read the Online Application Guide regarding the application system.

ERASMUS+ ENGLISH LANGUAGE EXAM

Erasmus+ English Language Exam will be held face to face at Istanbul Nişantaşı University campus. The exact timing will be announced later.

Note: It is obligatory to have your student IDs with you during the exam, to show your ID to the instructor before starting the exam, and to sign the attendance list.

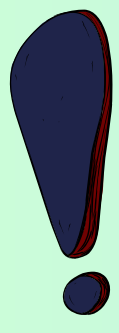
Those who do not have their student ID cards with them will not be allowed to sit for the exam. And the exams of those who do not sign the attendance list, will be deemed invalid.

Participation in the exam is mandatory for Erasmus+ KA-171 Study Mobility. Requirements are minimum 70 points for Erasmus+ Study Mobility Program from the English Foreign Language Exam.

ATTENTION!

Language exams such as YDS, TOEFL, IELTS are not accepted. It is compulsory for every student to take the language exam held by our university.

Students who are abroad or out of Istanbul for Erasmus+ Mobility Program also can apply; but in the period of the foreign language exam, students are required to take part in the exam in Istanbul, Türkiye. Students who are staying abroad or any other city of Türkiye on the exam date will not be regarded as a force majeure.

Necessary Points:

*Students who are entitled to receive a grant within the framework of Erasmus+ Study

Mobility can receive grants for 1 semester.

*The mobility to be performed within the scope of this announcement is limited to the duration of the project numbered 2024-1-TR01-KA171-HED-000219519.

* Erasmus+ Study and Internship Mobility can be held up to a total of 12 months at each level of education (first degree: associate degree, bachelor's degree; second degree: Master's degree; third degree: doctorate, specialization in medicine).

WHO CAN APPLY?

Students who are in the 1st and 2nd grades of Formal Education (1st and 2nd Education) Associate, Undergraduate and Postgraduate students at Istanbul Nişantaşı University can apply for study mobility.

Students enrolled in the Double Major / Minor Program can only apply from one Major.

Those who have previously carried out Erasmus+ Mobility Program at the same and/or previous level of education can apply. However, it should not be forgotten that Erasmus+ Mobility can be done up to 12 months in total at each education level.

Final/last year students cannot apply for Erasmus+ Study Mobility. They can only apply for Erasmus+ Internship mobility.

WHO CANNOT APPLY?

English Preparatory, Scientific Preparation, Open and Distance Education students cannot apply to Erasmus+ Study Mobility.

Students who freeze their registration cannot apply.

Students who continue their education at our university with any exchange program cannot apply.

Final/last year students can not apply for Erasmus+ Study Mobility. They can only apply for Erasmus+ Internship mobility.

Attention: Graduate students and those who did not renew their registration, cannot apply for Erasmus+ Mobility.



Erasmus+ Study Mobility Application Requirements

1. The student must be actively enrolled in one of the programs listed above within the higher education institution.
2. A minimum GPA of 2.20/4.00 for undergraduate students and 3.00/4.00 for graduate (master's and PhD) students is required.
3. The student must have a sufficient number of ECTS credits (30 ECTS) available for the study mobility.
4. If the student has previously participated in Erasmus+ or Lifelong Learning Programme (LLP) higher education mobility activities at the current level of study, the total duration (including the new mobility) must not exceed 12 months.

Students who do not meet these criteria are not eligible to apply.

Having failed courses from previous semesters does not prevent a student from applying for KA-171 Erasmus+ Study Mobility.

5- Those who have transferred from another higher education institution and haven't yet achieved a grade point average (GPA), the grade averages in the transcript they receive from the higher education institution they take are taken into consideration.



ATTENTION!

Before the **APPLICATION PROCESS**, students must make sure that their General Weighted Grade Point Average (GPA) is up-to-date and correct in the OBIS system. As the GPA on the OBIS system takes into consideration, the students must enter OBIS and if they have the missing course or course grade, have to be corrected by the Student Affairs Office. Arrangements to be made after the application process will not be taken into consideration.

Evaluation Criteria

It will be taken into consideration 50% of the Erasmus+ English Language Score and 50% of the General Weighted Grade Point Average (GPA). The sum of these points constitutes the final score (Erasmus+ Score).

According to the evaluation criteria stated below, the student's final score (Erasmus+Score) must be a minimum of **64** for Erasmus+Study Mobility.

Reminder: The threshold for passing the Erasmus+ English Language exam is minimum 70 points for Erasmus+ Study Mobility.

Even if a student is selected for mobility, it is not possible to participate in the mobility if 30 ECTS credits cannot be matched with courses at the host institution.

For study mobility, students must have a sufficient ECTS course load.

For students who do not have regular coursework—such as those in the thesis stage of their master's or PhD studies—a Learning Agreement can be prepared based on a 30 ECTS equivalent academic workload that is not in the form of regular courses.

In any case, academic eligibility must be confirmed by the student's registered department/faculty/institute. If the mobility is not deemed academically appropriate, the student cannot participate in the mobility, even if they have been selected.

SELECTION CRITERIA AND WEIGHTED POINTS TO BE USED IN EVALUATING APPLICATIONS

Language Level	%50 (Over 100 hundred points)
Martyr and Veteran Children	+15 points *
Disabled students (provided that the disability is documented)	+10 points **
Those who receive or whose first-degree relatives receive social aid from AFAD due to the “6 February Earthquake Disaster”	+10 points
The students who have been decided to protect, care or shelter under the Social Services Law No. 2828	+10 points***
Benefit before (with or without grant)	-10 points
Participating in mobility in the country of citizenship	-10 points
The student who has given up participating in Erasmus Mobility the previous year without a valid reason although he/she was qualified.	-10 points
Apply to both of mobility program at the same time (a reduction is applied to the student's preferred mobility)	-10 points
For students selected for mobility: to attend meetings/training related to mobility organized by the higher education institution without excuse (applied if the student reapplies to Erasmus)	-5 points
Declaring that he will take the language exam without an excuse (if the student re-applies to Erasmus)	-5 points

Grant Amounts

Grants are given to students to help them with their additional expenses resulting from being abroad during their study period. Grants are only for contribution, and not intended to cover all the student's mobility costs. For Erasmus+ Mobility, students are not supported for round- trip journeys.

In addition to the monthly grant, for mobilities with Third Countries Not Associated with the Programme, students are also provided with additional support for round-trip travel costs.

The amount of travel support must be calculated using the Distance Calculator, which can be accessed via the following link:

Using the Distance Calculator, the distance in kilometers between the sending institution and the host institution must be determined. Then, the travel grant should be calculated using the table below:

The amount shown in the table corresponds to a round-trip and should not be multiplied by two.

If the student travels with connecting flights or transfers, this does not affect the distance calculated through the tool.

*2024 Project Year Erasmus+ KA-171 Study Mobility applications will be taken ONLINE via turnaportal.ua.gov.tr between August 1, 2025 and September 1, 2025. Applications will not be accepted after the relevant dates.

* In academic matters, students should contact the Erasmus Department Coordinators regarding all questions.

*You can send an e-mail to erasmus@nisantasi.edu.tr regarding the technical problems you face during the application.

Students who submit their applications by making an incorrect or incomplete application do not have the right to change their applications again. Therefore, you should be careful while applying.
